Did Jesus lie when He said, “He who believes and is baptized shall be saved; he who disbelieves shall be condemned”? (Mark 16:16)

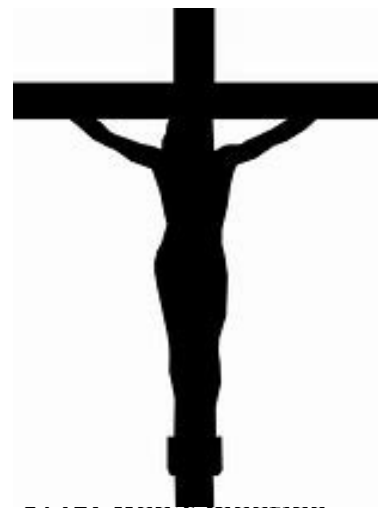
