BIBLE FACTS

*John Wycliffe produced the first translation of the entire Bible from Latin Vulgate into English. However, after he died, the Catholic Church exhumed and burned his corpse as punishment for his translation.

* William Tyndale produced first printed edited of the New Testament in English. He was later burned at the stake for his efforts.

*The Geneva Bible was the first Bible to use numbered verses. It was the Bible used by Shakespeare and the one that Pilgrims brought to America in 1620.

*There are 365 “fear not” verses in the Bible; one for every day of the year.

*Using the words from the original languages, both Jeremiah (33,002 words) and Genesis (32,046 words) are longer than Psalms (30,147 words).

*The words “trinity” and “providence” are not used in the Bible. They are theological terms.

*There were seven pairs of clean animals on Noah’s ark.

*In 1631, a publishing company accidentally printed “Thou shalt commit adultery.” Only six of those Bibles exist today. They are called “The Sinner’s Bible.”

WHY ONLY ONE SONG LEADER?

Choirs. Praise Teams. Quartets. Duets. Most denominations (and even some churches of Christ) have multiple singers leading worship on Sundays. This is not a new thing in the denominational world. Choirs have been around since the earliest centuries A.D.

But *should* we worship with multiple leaders? Should we sing along with a choir, or just listen to a group sing to us?

The Bible is clear that we should teach and admonish “one another with psalms and hymns and spiritual songs” (Col. 3:16). But the Bible does not command us to sing a certain set of songs, nor does it teach us how many songs to sing or who should start and finish the song—but all of those things must be determined if we are to sing as a group.

Having one song leader is necessary in order for us to sing together. Multiple singers is unnecessary, and it
