GOSSIP

"And just as they did not see fit to acknowledge God any longer, God gave them over to a depraved mind, to do those things which are not proper, being filled with all unrighteousness, wickedness, greed, evil; full of envy, murder, strife, deceit, malice; they are gossips, slanderers, haters of God..." (Romans 1:28-30).

As the apostle Paul detailed the sins of the Gentiles, he noted that gossiping was among their worst traits. Most people today would not lump gossip with murder and greed, because most Christians categorize sins by relative consequences. Murder has permanent consequences, whereas gossip's consequences can be rectified.

But our thinking is flawed. Gossip does have permanent consequences. Once lies, white lies, half-truths, and innuendos circulate it is impossible to retrieve them all. The whispers eventually turn into regular conversation, then regular conversations produce reputations.

To prevent gossip in your life...

- 1. Cut the chain. Don't pass along any information that is salacious, unconfirmed, or vengeful.
- 2. Let your speech always be with grace..." (Col. 4:6).
- 3. Practice the Golden Rule. Would you want your worst acts discussed behind your back just so somebody could enjoy telling a "good story"? Of course not.
