## Joy and Unity: Paul's Prayer for Love (Philippians 1:1-11)

Today we begin a new sermon series on Paul's wonderful letter to the Philippians entitled Joy and Unity. This letter is somewhat unique among his epistles because it reads much more like a personal letter to friends than some of his other writings such as Galatians and Corinthians. Two major themes of Philippians include the concepts of Joy and Unity, which are two things that are desperately needed in the world, and even the church, today.



"And now abide faith, hope, love, these three; but the greatest of these is love"

In this morning's lesson, we will focus on the beginning of the letter where Paul offers a prayer that is focused on love  $(\alpha \gamma \alpha \pi \eta / agape)$ . Before he gets to the prayer in verse 9, he first explains:

For Whom He Prays (1-2) – "saints," "overseers," and "deacons" at Philippi

When He Prays (3-4) – "all my remembrance of you, always in every prayer of mine"

**How He Prays (4)** – "making my prayer with **joy**"

Why He Prays (5-8) – "because of your partnership in the gospel"

"you are all partakers with me"

After this introduction, he then explains the specific things that he prays for, and all of these things are related to love ( $\dot{\alpha}\gamma\dot{\alpha}\pi\eta$  / agape).
