¹My little children, I am writing these things to you so that you may not sin. But if anyone does sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous. παράκλητος paraklētos

²He is the **propitiation** for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the sins of the whole world. ίλασμός - hilasmos (only here and 4:10)

³And by this we know that we have come to know him, if we keep his commandments.

⁴Whoever says "I know him" but does not keep his commandments is a liar, and the truth is not in him,

⁵but whoever keeps his word in him truly the **love of God** is perfected. By this we may be sure that we are in him:

⁶whoever says he abides in him ought to walk in the same way in τελειόω teleioō - Continuous growth which he walked.

⁷Beloved, I am writing you no new commandment, but an old commandment that you had from the beginning. The old commandment is the word that you have heard.

⁸At the same time, it is a new commandment that I am writing to you, which is true in him and in you, because the darkness is passing away and the true light is already shining.

⁹Whoever says he is in the **light** and hates his brother is still in darkness.

¹⁰Whoever **loves his brother** abides in the **light**, and in him there is no cause for stumbling.

¹¹But whoever hates his brother is in the **darkness** and walks in the darkness, and does not know where he is going, because the darkness has blinded his eyes.

¹²I am writing to you, little children, because your sins are forgiven for his name's sake.

¹³I am writing to you, **fathers**, because you know him who is from the beginning. I am writing to you, young men, because you have overcome the evil one. I write to you, children, because you know the Father.

¹⁴I write to you, **fathers**, because you know him who is from the beginning. I write to you, young men, because you are strong, and the word of God abides in you, and you have overcome the evil one.

¹⁵Do not **love the world** or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him.

¹⁶For all that is in the world—the desires of the flesh and the desires of the eyes and pride in possessions—is not from the Father but is from the world.

¹⁷And the world is passing away along with its desires, but whoever does the will of God abides forever.
