We Know: Study of I John – 1 John 3:1-10 Pleasant View Church of Christ – January 29, 2023

Continuation of the thought in 2:29:

"everyone who practices righteousness has been

born of him" -Rom 8:12-17

The world saw the human Jesus, but didn't recognize him as the Son of God

-Jn 5:36-40; 7:25-31; 16:1-4 -1Co 1:18; 2:14 ¹See what kind of **love** the Father has given to us, that we should be called children of God; and so we are. The reason why the world does not know us is that it did not know him. We should not be surprised that the \circ world does not know or understand us!

Approval by the world should be feared rather than desired!

We do not possess full knowledge of the life that is to come, but we believe in the promise! -Rom 5:1-2; 8:18

Those who have confidence in the return of the Christ will aim to be like Him in purity and righteousness. -1Jn 2:6; 3:7, 16; 4:17

If one continues with sin as their master, they are declining the payment that Jesus made and the only way to have peace with God

How does John draw a distinction between those that are righteous and those that are lawless?

²Beloved, we are God's children now, and what we will be has not yet appeared; but we know that when he appears we shall be like him, because we shall see him as he is.

Phil 3:20-21

³And everyone who **thus hopes** in him <u>purifies himself</u> as he is pure. <- The sign that one has chosen Christ as their master

⁴Everyone who makes a practice of *sinning* also practices lawlessness; sin is lawlessness. <- The sign that one has chosen the devil as their master (8)

⁵You know that he appeared to take away sins, and in him there is no sin. **▼**·····... 1Jn 1:5; 2:1-2; Rom 5:1-2

⁶No one who abides in him keeps on sinning; no one who keeps on sinning has either seen him or *known* him.

Jn 8:19; 14:7, 9; 1Jn 2:3-6; 3Jn 11

⁷Little children, *let no one deceive you*. Whoever practices righteousness is righteous, as he is righteous.

⁸Whoever makes a practice of sinning is of the devil, *for* the devil has been sinning from the beginning. The reason the **Son of God** appeared was to **destroy the**. works of the devil. <- Jn 8:44; 1Jn 2:1-2; Heb 10:12

⁹No one born of God makes a <u>practice of sinning</u>, for God's seed *abides in him*, and he cannot keep on sinning because he has been born of God. <- 1 Jn 2:26-29

¹⁰By this it is evident who are the **children of God**, and who are the **children of the devil**: whoever does not practice righteousness is not of God, nor is the one who does not love his brother.

This type of Love was not known to John's opponents

> 1Jn 1:6,8; 2:3-6 Romans 6:1-4, 12-14

Continued refutation of early Gnostic teaching

How did Christ accomplish this mission? -By providing payment for sins!
