

1Jn 3:10 - How do
we know if we are a
child of God of a
child of the devil?

¹¹For this is the message that you have heard from the beginning,
that we should love one another.

¹²We should not be like Cain, who was of the evil one and
murdered his brother. And why did he murder him? Because his
own deeds were evil and his brother's righteous.

¹³Do not be surprised, brothers, that the world hates you.

¹⁴We know that we have passed out of death into life, because we
love the brothers. Whoever does not love abides in death.

¹⁵Everyone who hates his brother is a murderer, and you know
that no murderer has eternal life abiding in him. <-- Mt 5:21-22

¹⁶By this we know love, that he laid down his life for us, and we
ought to lay down our lives for the brothers.

How can we know
whether we would
sacrifice our life
for a brother?

¹⁷But if anyone has the world's goods and sees his brother in
need, yet closes his heart against him, how does God's love abide
in him?

¹⁸Little children, let us not love in word or talk but in deed and in

heart before him;

²⁰for whenever our heart condemns us, God is greater than our
heart, and he knows everything.

²¹Beloved, if our heart does not condemn us, we have confidence

²²and whatever we ask we receive from him, because we keep his
commandments and do what pleases him.

²³And this is his commandment, that we believe in the name of his
Son Jesus Christ and love one another, just as he has commanded
us.

²⁴Whoever keeps his commandments abides in him, and he in
them. And by this we know that he abides in us, by the Spirit
whom he has given us. <-- Acts 2:38; Rom 8:9-11
