<sup>1</sup>Everyone who believes that Jesus is the Christ has been born of God, and everyone who loves the Father loves whoever has been born of him.

God and obey his commandments. <- God's commandments speak to both our HORIZONTAL and VERTICAL relationships

This verse is the reverse of what is expected, but one cannot truly love the children of God without also loving God!

-Mt 22:34-40

<sup>3</sup>For this is the *love of God*, that we keep his commandments. And his commandments are not burdensome. <- Matt 11:28-30

<sup>4</sup>For <u>everyone</u> who has been *born of God overcomes the world*. And this is the *victory* that has *overcome the world—our faith*.

that Jesus is the Son of God? <- 1Jn 4:4; Jn 16:33;
Rom 3:21-26; Eph 2:8-10

<sup>6</sup>This is he who came by *water and blood*—Jesus Christ; not by the water only but by the water and the blood. And the *Spirit* is the one who testifies, because the *Spirit* is the truth.

<sup>7</sup>For there are three that *testify*:

8the *Spirit* and the *water* and the *blood*; and these three agree.

<sup>9</sup>If we receive the *testimony of men*, the *testimony of God is greater*, for this is the testimony of God that he has borne concerning his Son. <- John 5:31-38

<sup>10</sup>Whoever *believes* in the Son of God has the testimony in himself. Whoever does not believe God *has made him a liar*, because he has not believed in the testimony that God has borne concerning his Son. <- 1Jn 2:23

<sup>11</sup>And this is the testimony, that God gave us *eternal life*, and this *life* is in his *Son*. <- 15n 1:1-2; 2:25; 3:15

<sup>12</sup>Whoever has the Son has *life*; whoever does not have the Son of God *does not have life*.
