In contrast to the antichrists

¹**Everyone** who *believes* that *Jesus is the Christ* has been *born of God*, and **everyone** who *loves the Father* loves whoever has been *born of him*.

²By this we know that we *love the children of God*, when we *love God* and *obey his commandments*. <- God's commandments speak to both our **HORIZONTAL** and **VERTICAL** relationships

This verse is the reverse of what is expected, but one cannot truly love the children of God without also loving God!

Our faith allows us to receive the free gift that overcomes the world (Rom 8:31-39)

³For this is the *love of God*, that *we keep his commandments*. And his commandments are *not burdensome*. <- Matt 11:28-30

⁴For **everyone** who has been *born of God* *overcomes the world*. And this is the *victory* that has *overcome the world—our faith*.

⁵Who is it that *overcomes the world* except the one who *believes* that *Jesus is the Son of God*? <- 1Jn 4:4; Jn 16:33; Rom 3:21-26; Eph 2:8-10

Not Burdensome

*To the natural man the requirements for righteousness are foreign and hard.

*When we trust in God's Son, his yoke becomes gentle and the burden light.

-Mt 11:30

*We who have been born of God have within us a desire and a yearning for the Father.

*Seeking and hungering after righteousness becomes our joy.

*Living the life of love becomes our delight.

(6-12)

All three of these testify that Jesus came in the flesh.

⁶This is he who came by *water and blood*—Jesus Christ; not by the water only but by the water and the blood. And the *Spirit* is the one who testifies, because the *Spirit* is the truth.

⁷For there are three that *testify*:

⁸the *Spirit* and the *water* and the *blood*; and these three agree.

⁹If we receive the *testimony of men*, the *testimony of God* is *greater*, for this is the testimony of God that he has borne concerning his Son. <- John 5:31-38

¹⁰Whoever *believes* in the Son of God has the testimony in himself. Whoever does not believe God *has made him a liar*, because he has not believed in the testimony that God has borne concerning his Son. <- 1Jn 2:23

¹¹And this is the testimony, that God gave us *eternal life*, and this *life* is in his *Son*. <- 1Jn 1:1-2; 2:25; 3:15

¹²Whoever has the Son has *life*; whoever does not have the Son of God *does not have life*.

We have the choice to either believe the testimony of men or of God. Each of these has a consequence!
