difficulty will a rich person enter the kingdom of heaven. <sup>24</sup>Again I tell you, it is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich person to enter the kingdom of God." <sup>25</sup>When the disciples heard this, they were greatly astonished, saying, "Who then can be saved?" <sup>26</sup>But Jesus looked at them and said, "With man this is impossible, but with God all things are possible." <sup>27</sup>Then <u>Peter</u> said in reply, "See, we have left everything and followed you. What then will we have?" <sup>28</sup>Jesus said to them, "Truly, I say to you, in the new world, when the Son of Man will sit on his glorious throne, you who have followed me will also sit on twelve thrones, judging the twelve tribes of Israel. <sup>29</sup>And evervone who has left houses or brothers or sisters or father or mother or children or lands, for my name's sake, will receive a hundredfold and will inherit eternal life. 30But many who are first deserving or earning will be last, and the last first.

-Obviously Peter still had a lot to learn about what this really meant!

Babbling - Mk 9:6

"he did not know what to say..." -Peter did not know what was happening, but offered his "two cents" anyway -Ecc 5:1-2

What is the significance of the # given by Christ?

How significant was Peter's sacrifice?

-Lk 5:11 - "they left everything and followed him"

-Mk 12:41-44 - "put in everything she had"
