Love Me

-The first two times Jesus asks this question, he uses the word ἀγαπάω (agapaō)

-The last time Jesus asks the question, he uses the word φιλέω (phileō)

-All three times Peter answers with the word φιλέω (phileō)

-While these words are similar in conveying a primary love, but phileō is closer to affection or friendship.

-John 14:15, 21, 23-24
-1Jn 2:3-6, 3:10, 21-24, 5:2-3

More than These

-Three possibilities for "These"

(1) You love the other disciples

(2) The other disciples love Christ
-Mt 26:33

(3) You love the things you are doing today (i.e. fishing)

-Luke 14:25-27

You Know

Instead of boasting in himself like in his previous declarations, Peter appeals to the knowledge of Christ for the answer.

You Will...

-Peter's following of Christ would require the sacrifice of his life as a martyr.

What About This Man?

Why did Peter ask this about John?

Jn 21:1-14 – 2nd great catch of fish (Lk 5:1-11)

John 21:15-23 (ESV)

¹⁵When they had finished breakfast, Jesus said to Simon Peter, "Simon, son of John, do you love me more than these?" He said to him, "Yes, Lord; you know that I love you." He said to him, "Feed my lambs."

¹⁶He said to him a second time, "Simon, son of John, do you love me?" He said to him, "Yes, Lord; you know that I love you." He said to him, "Tend my sheep."

¹⁷He said to him the third time, "Simon, son of John, do you love me?" Peter was grieved because he said to him the third time, "Do you love me?" and he said to him, "Lord, you know everything; you know that I love you." Jesus said to him, "Feed my sheep."

Indicates that Jesus' words were serious (significant)

¹⁸Truly, truly, I say to you, when you were young, you used to dress yourself and walk wherever you wanted, but when you are old, you will stretch out your hands, and another will dress you and carry you where you do not want to go."

¹⁹(This he said to show by what kind of death he was to glorify God.) And after saying this he said to him, "Follow me." <- Verb tense indicates continual action

²⁰Peter turned and saw the disciple whom Jesus loved following them, the one who also had leaned back against him during the supper and had said, "Lord, who is it that is going to betray you?"

²¹When Peter saw him, he said to Jesus, "Lord, what about this man?"

²²Jesus said to him, "If it is my will that he remain until I come, what is that to you? You follow me!"

²³So the saying spread abroad among the brothers that this disciple was not to die; yet Jesus did not say to him that he was not to die, but, "If it is my will that he remain until I come, what is that to you?"

The three questions Jesus addressed to Peter stand in contrast to:

-His three denials

- Mt 26:69-75
- Mk 14:66-72
- Lk 22:54-62
- Jn 18:15-18

-His previous declarations

- Lk 22:31-33
- Jn 13:33-38
- Mt 26:31-35
- Mk 14:27-31

Feeding Sheep (15-17)

-Jesus' instruction takes three different forms

(1) Feed my lambs ἀρνίον (arnion):

Be a teacher to those just beginning their walk with Christ.

(2) Tend my sheep πρόβατον (probaton):

Take care of those who are more mature in their faith.

(3) Feed my sheep πρόβατον (probaton):

Continue to teach those who are more mature in their faith.

Following Christ (19, 22)

-This echoes Jesus' questions on love as true love to Christ requires obedience

-Jesus is emphasizing that that following Him is a lifetime commitment, regardless of the consequences.
