

<sup>13</sup> Now when Jesus *heard this*, <u>he withdrew</u> from there in a boat to a **desolate place** by himself. *But when the crowds heard it, they followed him on foot from the towns*.

<sup>14</sup> When he went ashore he saw *a great crowd*, and <u>he had compassion</u> on them and healed their sick.

<sup>15</sup> Now when it was evening, the disciples came to him and said, "This is a desolate place, and the day is now over; **send the crowds away** to go into the villages and buy food for themselves."

<sup>16</sup> But Jesus said, "They need not go away; you give them something to eat."

<sup>17</sup> They said to him, "We have only five loaves here and two fish."

<sup>18</sup> And he said, "Bring them here to me."

<sup>19</sup> Then he ordered the crowds to sit down on the grass, and taking the *five loaves and the two fish*, he looked up to heaven and said a blessing. Then <u>he broke the loaves</u> <u>and gave them to the disciples</u>, and the disciples gave them to the crowds.

<sup>20</sup> And they all ate and were satisfied. And they took up *twelve baskets full of the broken pieces left over*.

<sup>21</sup> And **those who ate were about five thousand men**, besides women and children.

Why Did Jesus Withdraw? (1) Death of John the Baptist > Mt 14:1-12 (2) Danger from Herod Antipas > Mt 14:1-12 (3) Stress from an escalation in His ministry > Jn 3:30 (4) Stress from the huge crowds > Mk 6:31 There will never be a situation in life that we will face where He will not understand!
