# The Greatest Command - Matthew 22:34-40 Pleasant View Church of Christ - August 20, 2023

#### Matthew 22:36-40 (ESV)

<sup>36</sup> "Teacher, which is the great commandment in the Law?" <sup>37</sup> And he said to him, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. <sup>38</sup> This is the great and first commandment. <sup>39</sup> And a second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself. <sup>40</sup> On these two commandments depend all the Law and the Prophets."

All of God's Commandments Deal with Loving God or Loving Neighbor - See Exodus 20:1-17 (The Ten Commandments)  $\rightarrow$  Consider that the first four commandments deal with loving God and the final six commandments deal with loving your neighbor.

#### **Love God**

In Mt 22:37, Jesus is quoting from a speech given by Moses in Deuteronomy 6:

#### **Deuteronomy 6:4-5 (ESV)**

<sup>4</sup> "Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. <sup>5</sup> You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might.

Later in Deuteronomy, Moses equates loving God with doing what God has commanded (see **Dt 10:12-13**):

#### **Deuteronomy 11:1 (ESV)**

- <sup>1</sup> "You shall therefore **love the Lord your God** and *keep his charge, his statutes, his rules, and his commandments always*.
  - *Jesus also equated the keeping of commandments to loving God (see John 14:15, 21, 23-24)*
  - John echoed these thoughts in explaining true knowledge of God (see 1]n 2:3-6; 3:10, 21-24; 5:2-3)

#### **Love Neighbor**

*In Mt 22:339, Jesus is quoting from God's instructions to Moses in Leviticus 19:* 

#### Leviticus 19:18 (ESV)

- <sup>18</sup> You shall not take vengeance or bear a grudge against the sons of your own people, but **you shall love your neighbor as yourself**: I am the Lord.
  - James referred to this command as the "Royal Law" in James 2:8
  - Paul explained that the Laws of God could be summed up in this one command (Rom 13:9-10) and were fulfilled in this one command (Gal 5:14).
