God Prepared Beforehand

God determined the steps we "should walk in" to receive his grace before the beginning of the world

Eph 1:3-5 Act 2:23

Rom 3:21; 8:29-30; 9

And you were dead in the trespasses and sins

Two ways to say the same thing (Col 2:13)

²in which **you once walked**, following the course of this world, following the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that is now at work in the sons of disobedience—

Jews were no better off than the Gentiles

³among whom we all once lived in the passions of our flesh, carrying out the desires of the body and the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, like the rest of mankind.

⁴<u>But God</u>, being *rich in mercy*, because of the *great love* with which he loved us,

Rom 5:6-11

⁵<u>even when</u> we were **dead** in our **trespasses**, **made** us alive together **with** Christ—by **grace** you have been saved—

Rom 6:4-11; Col 2:12

⁶and raised us up with him and seated us with him in the death... heavenly places in Christ Jesus,

⁷so that in the coming ages *he might show* the immeasurable riches of his grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus.

¹⁰For we are *his workmanship*, created in Christ Jesus *for good works*, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.

Two things they once followed...

(1) Course of this World

*Course = $\alpha i \acute{\omega} v (ai\bar{o}n)$

-Literally "Age"

*World = κόσμος (kosmos)

-1Cor 3:18-19

(2) Prince of the Power of the Air

*Refers to the devil

-John 14:30; 16:11

-1Cor 2:12

-Eph 4:27; 6:11,16

*Ancients believed that the "air" (aeros)—the sphere between heaven and earth—was the residence of evil spirits (i.e. Demons)

But God ...

Rescued us from certain death

What:

All three verbs begin with "ou" (sy) in the original language

*Made us Alive (5)

*Raised us Up (6)

*Seated us with Him (6)

Why:

*Rich in Mercy (4)
*Great Love (4)
*He might Show...Grace (7)

How:

*In Christ Jesus (6,7,10)
*By **Grace** through
Faith (5,8)

Faith in Christ makes it possible to receive salvation by God's grace, and will naturally result in "good works," but does not in any way cause us to earn our salvation.
