Role of Parents (v. 4)

To guide towards (v. 4b):

R

- This has implications for their physical and spiritual life.
- Train them how to be friendly, respectful, courteous, professional, good stewards, hard workers, empathetic, encouraging, etc. (i.e. how to be an adult).
- Train them to avoid the pitfalls of the world.

R

- Be Children of God
- Be Trained in His Word
- Take Ownership of Their Faith
- Be Lights in the World
- Live with God in Glory

How to do it...offer (v. 4a):

R______ - Show understanding of their perspective, fears, stresses, and worries. Their "problems" may seem trivial to us, but they can be very real to them.

should be the greatest source of encouragement for their children.

Role of Children (vv. 1-3)

R______ - "obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right"

-Do what they tell you ... with understanding that they are trying to guide you toward:

Responsibility and Relationship.

R______ - "Honor your father and mother"

-Recognize their authority and show them respect...with understanding that they have experienced a lot more things in life than you have. Live the way they are teaching you, even when you are not around them.
