Instructions from Paul to Timothy, his "true child in the Faith" (1Ti 1:2)

If the Law can't bring salvation, why was it given? To provide...
 -A Reason for Seeking (Gal 3:19-26)
 -A Roadmap for Serving (Gal 5:13-26)

Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right.

Col 3:20 -> "...for this pleases the Lord."

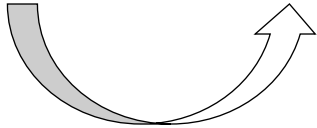
Honor τιμάω (timaō)

"The form love assumes towards those who are placed above us by God"

i.e. do not abuse your authority

Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger, but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord.

Col 3:21 -> "...lest they become discouraged."



Role of Parents (v. 4)

To guide towards (v. 4b):

R _____

- This has implications for their physical and spiritual life.
- Train them how to be friendly, respectful, courteous, professional, good stewards, hard workers, empathetic, encouraging, etc. (i.e. how to be an adult).
- Train them to avoid the pitfalls of the world.

R _____

- Be Children of God
- Be Trained in His Word
- Take Ownership of Their Faith
- Be Lights in the World
- Live with God in Glory

How to do it...offer (v. 4a):

R _____ - It is critical that we be friends with our children ... have a relationship with them. Nurture their inherent trust in us. Learn about their needs, personality, and desires. To do this, we must spend quality time with them!

R _____ - Show understanding of their perspective, fears, stresses, and worries. Their "problems" may seem trivial to us, but they can be very real to them.

R _____ - Parents should be the greatest source of encouragement for their children.

R _____ - Our relationship with our children should be a safe-haven for them. A place where they feel loved, secure, protected. A place where they can share their fears. A place where they can go for encouragement.

Role of Children (vv. 1-3)

R _____ - "obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right"

-Do what they tell you ... with understanding that they are trying to guide you toward:

Responsibility and Relationship.

R _____ - "Honor your father and mother"

-Recognize their authority and show them respect...with understanding that they have experienced a lot more things in life than you have. Live the way they are teaching you, even when you are not around them.

-Read Paul's final instructions to Timothy in II Timothy (see above)
