

Praise (3,7)

- "Blessed" in vs. 3 is  
only used in relation to  
God in the NT. This is  
NOT the same word used by  
Jesus in Mt 5:3-11.

<sup>1</sup>Peter, an *apostle of Jesus Christ*, To those who are  
**elect exiles** of the Dispersion in **Pontus, Galatia,  
Cappadocia, Asia, and Bithynia**, < *Roman provinces in  
Asia Minor (Turkey)*

<sup>2</sup>according to the **foreknowledge** of God the Father, in  
the **sanctification** of the Spirit, for **obedience** to Jesus  
Christ and for sprinkling with his **blood**: May grace and  
peace be multiplied to you. <- *The Triune work of God*

<sup>3</sup>**Blessed** be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus  
Christ! According to his **great mercy**, he has caused  
us to be **born again** to a **living hope** through the  
**resurrection** of Jesus Christ from the dead,

<sup>4</sup>to an **inheritance** that is **imperishable, undefiled,  
and unfading**, kept in heaven for you,

<sup>5</sup>who by God's power are being **guarded through faith**  
for a **salvation** ready to be revealed in the last time.

<sup>6</sup>In this you **rejoice**, though now for a little while, if  
necessary, you have been **grieved** by various **trials**,

<sup>7</sup>so that the **tested** genuineness of your **faith**—more  
precious than gold that perishes though it is **tested by  
fire**—may be found to result in **praise and glory and  
honor** at the revelation of Jesus Christ.

<sup>8</sup>Though **you have not seen him**, you love him. Though  
you do not now see him, you believe in him and rejoice  
with **joy** that is inexpressible and filled with glory,

<sup>9</sup>obtaining the outcome of your faith, the **salvation** of  
your souls.

<sup>10</sup>Concerning this **salvation**, the *prophets* who  
prophesied about the grace that was to be yours  
**searched and inquired** carefully,

<sup>11</sup>inquiring what person or time the **Spirit of Christ** in  
them was indicating when he predicted the sufferings  
of Christ and the subsequent glories.

<sup>12</sup>It was **revealed** to them that they were serving not  
themselves but you, in the things that have now been  
announced to you through those who preached the  
good news to you by the **Holy Spirit** sent from heaven,  
things into which angels long to look.

-Because the message of  
the prophets concerning  
this salvation (9) did  
not originate with them,  
they did not always  
understand what they were  
communicating and sought  
further guidance (e.g.,  
Dan 8:27; 12:8)

-It was revealed to them  
that their message was  
concerning future  
generations...

-The source of the  
message to the prophets,  
and the source of the  
message to those teaching  
the gospel, was the  
same...God's Holy Spirit
