Name was Simon (Greek) /Simeon (Hebrew)

*Acts 15:14; 2Pet 1:1

Was given the Aramaic nickname "Cephas" by Jesus / "Peter" is the Greek translation of "Cephas" or "rock"

-"Blessed" in vs. 3 is only used in relation to God in the NT. This is NOT the same word used by Jesus in Mt 5:3-11.

¹Peter, an apostle of Jesus Christ, To those who are elect exiles of the Dispersion in Pontus, Galatia, Cappadocia, Asia, and Bithynia, < Roman provinces in Asia Minor (Turkey)

²according to the **foreknowledge** of God the Father, in the **sanctification** of the Spirit, for **obedience** to Jesus Christ and for sprinkling with his **blood**: May grace and peace be multiplied to you. <- The Triune work of God

³Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! According to his great mercy, he has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the **resurrection** of Jesus Christ from the dead,

4to an **inheritance** that is **imperishable, undefiled,** and unfading, kept in heaven for you,

⁵who by God's power are being **guarded through faith** for a **salvation** ready to be revealed in the last time.

⁶In this you **rejoice**, though now for a little while, if necessary, you have been grieved by various trials,

⁷so that the **tested** genuineness of your **faith**—more precious than gold that perishes though it is tested by fire—may be found to result in praise and glory and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ.

8Though you have not seen him, you love him. Though you do not now see him, you believe in him and rejoice with **joy** that is inexpressible and filled with glory,

⁹obtaining the outcome of your faith, the **salvation** of your souls.

¹⁰Concerning this **salvation**, the *prophets* who Guarded through faith (5) prophesied about the grace that was to be yours searched and inquired carefully,

> ¹¹inquiring what person or time the **Spirit of Christ** in them was indicating when he predicted the sufferings of Christ and the subsequent glories.

¹²It was **revealed** to them that they were serving not themselves but you, in the things that have now been announced to you through those who preached the good news to you by the **Holy Spirit** sent from heaven, generations... things into which angels long to look.

(10-12)

-Because the message of the prophets concerning this salvation (9) did not originate with them, they did not always understand what they were communicating and sought further guidance (e.g., Dan 8:27; 12:8)

-It was revealed to them that their message was concerning future

-The source of the message to the prophets, and the source of the message to those teaching the gospel, was the same...God's Holy Spirit
