Do You Have an Anchor?

Recently, Olivia and I have been planning for a family vacation next summer to Italy, Greece, and Turkey. The middle part of this trip will be a cruise on *Voyager of the Seas ("Voyager")*, which will be our second time to travel on this ship. The first time was on a Caribbean cruise for our fifth anniversary (we just celebrated our 27th) when Voyager was not only a new ship but was also the largest cruise ship in the world (incidentally, it is now ranked 62nd).



At the time, Voyager was not only known for its size, but also for its many technological advancements. I remember we attended a short briefing where one of the officers discussed a few of the technical highlights of the ship. One of these was that even though there were anchors available, the boat was designed to never need them outside of a port. He said the computer system could fire thrusters to keep the ship perfectly positioned without using the anchors. All the officers had to do was tell the system to maintain position, and the thrusters would do the rest. This was demonstrated at one of our stops, which did not have a port. The ship remained stationary in the bay, all while the massive anchors at the front of the boat remained retracted.

Unlike Voyager, we do not come equipped with this type of system. As long as our hope, our faith, and our purpose are focused on this life alone, we are going to be tossed about by our own failures and the uncertain nature of the world around us. Consider these words of Paul and Jesus...

Romans 7:18 (ESV) - For I know that nothing good dwells in me, that is, in my flesh. For I have the desire to do what is right, but not the ability to carry it out.

Matthew 6:19 (ESV) - Do not lay up for yourselves treasures **on earth**, where moth and rust destroy and where thieves break in and steal...

We MUST have an anchor that is beyond ourselves and beyond this life. In **Hebrews 6:13-20**, the writer is talking about the certainty of the promise made to Abraham. In giving this promise, God swore an oath by Himself. While an oath was not necessary for the creator of the universe, He did this to show the heirs of the promise (**Gal 3:7, 29**) that we can "hold fast to the hope set before us..." Regarding this hope (i.e. confident expectation), the writer continues:

Hebrews 6:19–20a (ESV) - We have this as a sure and steadfast **anchor of the soul**, a hope that enters into the inner place behind the curtain, where Jesus has gone as a forerunner on our behalf...

Unlike the high priest on the Day of Atonement, we will follow after our high priest into eternal glory. This is our hope and our anchor! However, the only way to have this anchor for our soul is to place our hope, faith, and purpose in the one who fulfilled the promise made to Abraham!
